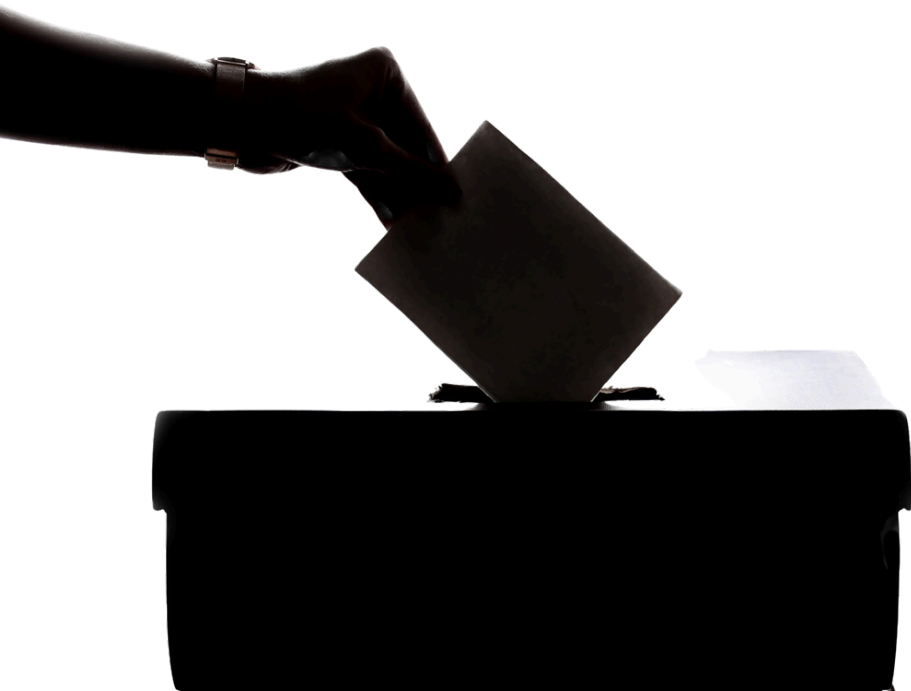

JUNE 2 - ELECTION DAY LAST DAY TO TURN IN BALLOTS

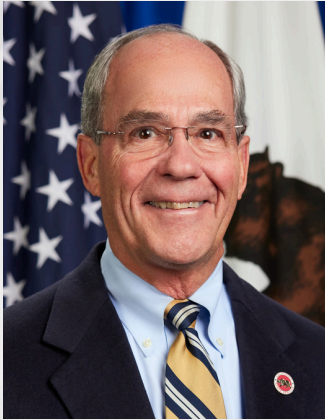
JUNE 9 - LAST DAY FOR COUNTY TO RECEIVE MAIL-IN BALLOTS



All registered voters will receive official ballots in the mail during the first week of May. Register to vote online at registertovote.ca.gov.

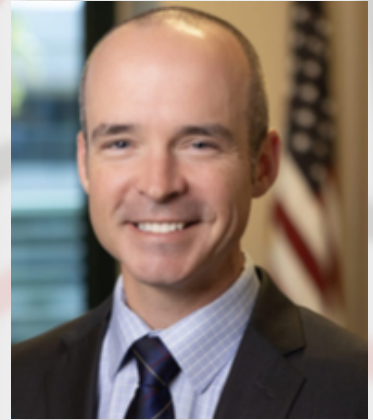
